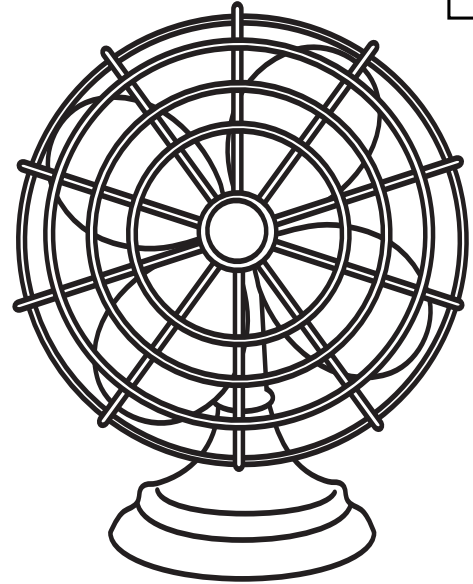

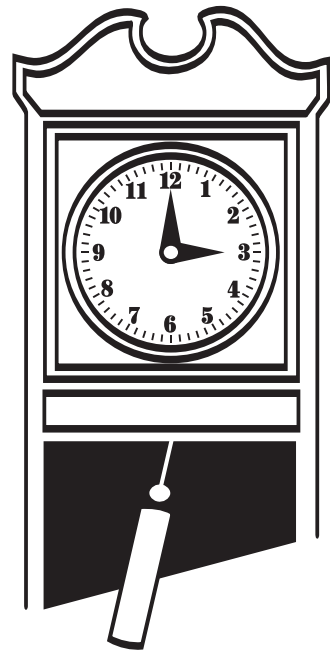
When I'm surprised, I often say o o o

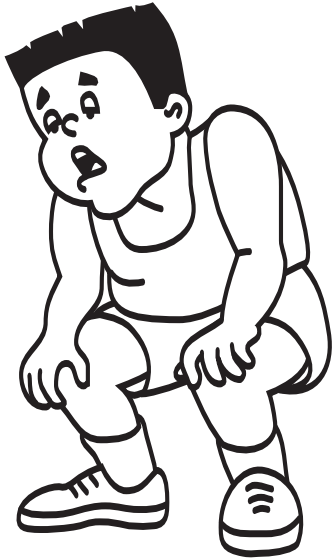
The heat makes the popcorn pop. p p p

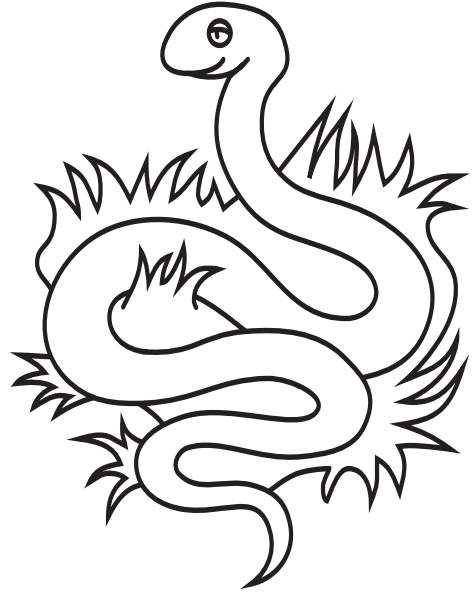
The roller coaster ride was quite a thrill. e e e

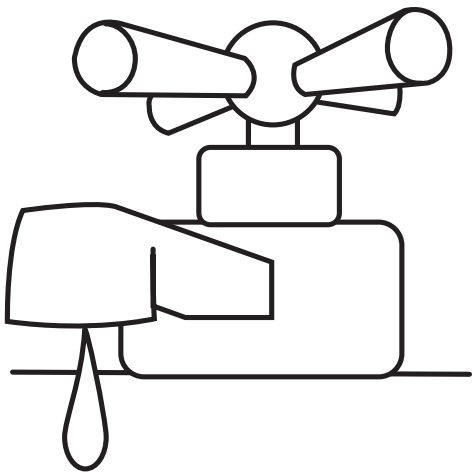
When I got to the end of the race, h h h

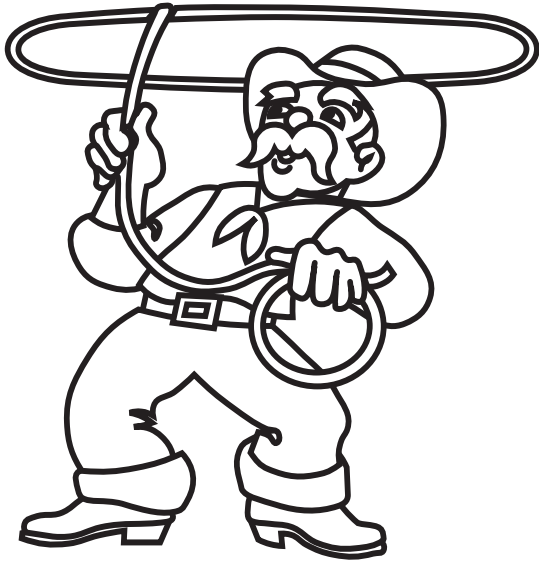
That dripping is a maddening sound. d d d

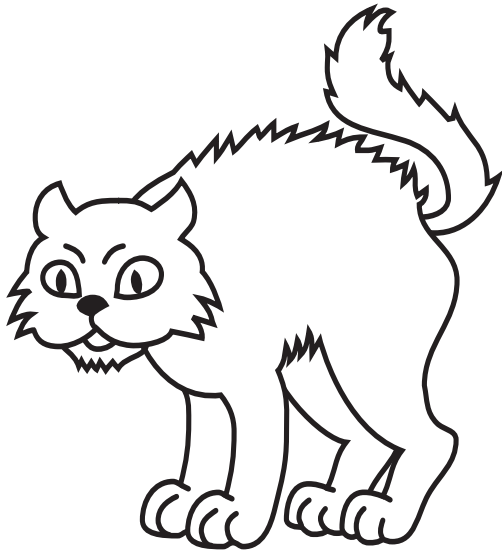
I dread the noise my alarm clock makes, I I I

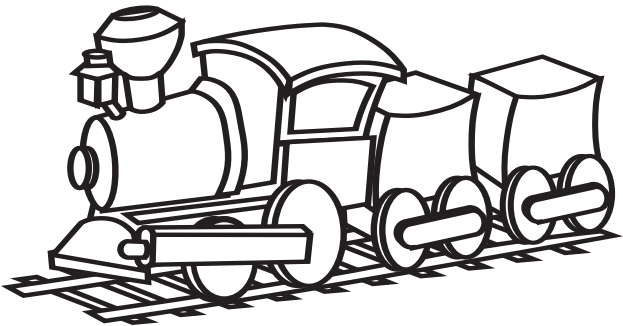
The vibrating motion is what it takes v v v

# Y



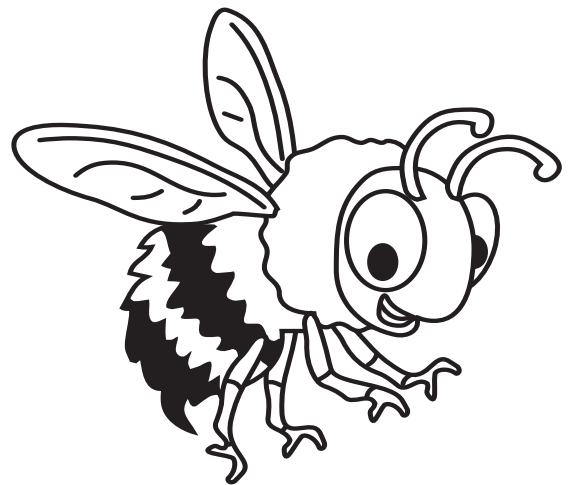
The yo-yo almost seems to sing y y y
